The OCIA Journey: Four Stages of Faith

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA) is a process of discovery, preparation, and transformation.

Here's what the journey looks like:

Inquirer – A time to ask questions and explore freely. It's a period of curiosity where you begin to learn about the Catholic faith.

Catechumen – A deeper season of learning and walking with the community after the Rite of Acceptance. Here, faith begins to take root as you study, pray, and share.

Elect – Marked by the Rite of Election during Lent, this is a time of prayer and spiritual preparation. It focuses on conversion of heart and final readiness for the sacraments.

Neophyte – After receiving the Sacraments of Initiation at Easter, you enter a period of growth, belonging, and deeper living of your new faith. This is when you begin to live as a full member of the Church.
